August 13 Luncheon Dr. Todd Freeman Vestavia Hills City Schools Supertintendent

Dr. Todd Freeman is beginning his seventh year as superintendent of Vestavia Hills City Schools. From 2013 to 2018, Dr. Freeman was superintendent of Sylacauga City Schools in east Alabama. Prior to that, he spent twenty years in Auburn City Schools as a social studies teacher and coach, high school principal, and executive director of operations and services.



During his time in Vestavia Hills City Schools, the district has renewed its accreditation, implemented a revised strategic plan, and opened three new schools. The school system has also broken numerous records that include test scores, college scholarship offers, and career and technical education credentialing. This year, the school system will be launching a

K-12 academic initiative that will provide new opportunities for profound learning in science, technology, engineering and math (STEM).

Dr. Freeman holds a bachelor's degree in education from Jacksonville State University, a master's in education from Auburn University, and a doctorate in educational leadership from Valdosta State University.


